

\$1,000 SCHOLARSHIP

NoTimeToKill.org Scholarship

The International Affairs Graduate Organization (INTAGO) presents the first NoTimeToKill.org Scholarship.

Bruce A. Roth, author of *No Time To Kill*, founder of notimetokill.org, and Georgia Tech graduate, will award a cash prize to an eligible Georgia Tech Sam Nunn School of International Affairs student who submits the best original paper supporting the elimination of WMDs. 1st prize is \$1,000; 2nd is \$250; 3rd is \$100.

Undergraduate juniors, seniors, and graduate students are eligible to participate. The paper should discuss the threat that WMDs pose to civilization, their ineffectiveness as a deterrent, and recommend how best to eliminate them globally. Students are encouraged to raise questions, single out issues, and identify dilemmas. This essay should be at least 2,000 words, but no more than 3,000 words excluding footnotes and bibliography. Papers should be submitted via email to bruce@notimetokill.org by March 15, 2007. The winner will be notified by April 10, 2007 and the prize will be awarded at the INTA Awards Banquet, April 17, 2007.
